

Water Efficient Demonstration Garden



Clackamas Community College (CCC), South Fork Water Board, the Regional Water Provider's Consortium, and partners in the green industry joined forces to create the **Water Efficient Demonstration Garden** at CCC's Oregon City campus. The garden is a model garden for the Portland metro region to teach the general public about several issues related to low water use landscapes - soil enhancements, the right plant/right place, selection of low water use plants, mulching, maintenance, and efficient irrigation practices.

Take a self-guided tour of the 7,000 sq ft garden, located at 19600 South Molalla Avenue, Oregon City, OR 97045.

- Take I-205 to the 213/Oregon City Exit.**
- Take Hwy 213 to the intersection of Beaver Creek Rd.**
- Take a left onto Beaver Creek Rd.**
- Go about a half a mile and turn right into the college.**
- Take a left into the first parking lot.**
- The garden is at the end of the parking lot.**



The Garden is open to the public seven days a week, any time of day.
